RECREATION

WASHOE LAKE STATE PARK

Washoe Lake State Park was established in 1977. The park provides 8,053 acres for year-round recreational use, including horse back riding, picnicking, boating, hiking, fishing, hunting, tent and RV camping.

DAVIS CREEK REGIONAL PARK

Davis Creek Park offers picnic areas, bird watching, hiking trails, equestrian trails, amphitheater, fishing pond, 62 campsites, group camping and views of Washoe Lake and Slide Mountain.

BOWERS MANSION REGIONAL PARK


Historically significant Bowers Mansion has expansive sunny lawn areas and numerous shade trees making a perfect spot for picnics. Bowers Mansion Pool and historic Bowers Mansion are both open seasonally with interpretive displays in an old root cellar and historic cemetery.

WILSON COMMONS PARK

Wilson Commons Park is located on Susan Lee Circle Road, accessed by William Brent Road, and features remnant historic Twaddle-Pedroli Ranch barn and stone ranch structures, a tennis court, picnic area, horseshoe pits, volleyball, and fishing pond.

WASHOE LAKE WETLANDS

Man-made wetland area, observation platform and pull-off sites are available to view water-fowl, shorebirds, gulls and three species of blackbirds.
